4. After careful examination, the Government accord sanction for establishment of two de-addiction centres exclusively for children each at Chennai and Tirunelveli Districts through the Non-Governmental Organisation who have vast experience in the field, at a total cost of Rs.45,91,600/- (Rupees forty five lakh, ninety one thousand and six hundred only) [Recurring expenditure - Rs.41,41,600/- and Non-Recurring expenditure Rs.4,50,000/-] @ Rs.22,95,800/- per Centre per annum [Recurring expenditure - Rs.20,70,800/- and Non-Recurring expenditure Rs.2,25,000/-] and accord financial sanction of Rs.21,54,000/- (Rupees twenty one lakh and fifty four thousand only) [Recurring expenditure for 5 months - Rs.17,04,000/- and Non-Recurring expenditure in full Rs.4,50,000/-] @ Rs.10,77,000/- per Centre [Recurring expenditure for 5 months - Rs.8,52,000/- and Non-Recurring expenditure in full Rs.2,25,000/-] for the year 2021-2022 as detailed in the annexure to this order.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

6. Necessary additional funds of RS.13,94,000/- will be provided in RE/FMA 2021-2022. Pending provision of such funds, the Director of Social Defence is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para-4 above. However the above expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislative Assembly by specific inclusion in Supplementary Estimate 2021-2022. The Director of Social Defence is directed to send necessary proposal for inclusion of this expenditure in RE/FMA 2021-2022 and also send necessary draft explanatory note for specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2021-2022 to Finance (BG-1/SW) Department at an appropriate time without fail.

7. The Director of Social Defence is also directed to select the reputed Non-Governmental Organisations who have vast experience in this field and place necessary proposals before the Grants-in-aid Committee for selection of the best Non-Governmental Organisation to implement the above scheme.
